Get to know about the author of the book. It is not about knowing their personal life or origin, but getting to know about their writing style and ways to approach things. It is better if you read an interview or blog about that author and make a picture in your mind. This will help you get to know about the author's context in the whole book. Moreover, knowing about the author will help you write the review further

Then, you need to get to know about the book, its title, the year it is published, and other physical details of the book to talk about it. After the author's introduction and book details, start with the first paragraph, where you will introduce the book. Your introduction will lay the ground for what the following discussion is about. You need to incorporate a thesis statement in this paragraph too. To make a thesis statement, you need to move on with studying the book.

After you are done reading the summary, start with the second paragraph that will entail the plot and summary of the review. In this paragraph, you need to mention the setting of the whole book. You need to tell the main themes and a basic summary of the book. This paragraph is about the details and specifications of the book. It will talk about the book's concepts that will tell the readers whether it is worth reading or not.

After this, you need to find out the pros and cons of the book. For this purpose, use websites or scholarly resources. You can also look for reviews written by other people to get an idea about the positive and negative aspects of the book. First, you need to state the positive aspects that the book imparts to the reader. It can include the moral lessons from the book and other themes that spread positivity.

After this section, move towards the negative aspects that will talk about the bad impact that the book might have on some readers. It can be like a critique on an element that the book negates totally. This will help to find the loopholes of the book easily. So, readers can decide whether they have to read it or not.

Once you are done, you can move on to actually formulate your thesis statement since now you have all the desired information to write one.
